The Interim Crew position is a summer time position to train hire and train a community member to be a crew member for Makali‘i and an community educator for Nā Kālai Wa‘a programs.

Qualifications:

- At least 18 years of age
- Demonstrates abilities to work in a focused manner to meet goals and objectives set forth
- Good communicator
 - Able to speak to a variety of people from different age groups, cultural backgrounds, and experience levels.
 - Can communicate efficiently through text, phone and email
- Able to take directions and follow through.
- Has the ability to be transported to NKW sites (either by yourself or through your ‘ohana).
 - NKW sites are located mostly between Hawi, Mahukona, and Kawaihae in Kohala, and occasionally Kalaemanō, Kona. NKW hosts programs across various school and community sites across the island and state. Any transportation required outside of our Kohala sites will be coordinated with the interns and program staff.
